

Sequoia Equipment Cleaning Recommendations AVC EDGE II and Insight - **Provided by Dominion Voting**

From a medical and healthcare aspect, it may be required to clean and disinfect your Insight and EDGE before, during and after use on Election Day.

Like all electronics, cleaning legacy equipment, such as the EDGE **while powered off**, with a soft cloth with **isopropyl alcohol and water solution at a ratio of 50:50 up to 100% isopropyl alcohol** is the standard.

Caution: Avoid potentially hazardous situations associated with the use of alcohol which may result in personal injury and property damage. **Do NOT spray cleaning / disinfecting agent directly on the equipment.**

To occasionally clean the EDGE screen throughout the day:

1. **Turn off the EDGE tabulator.**
2. Spray a small amount of cleaning agent (formula noted above) onto the cloth (never spray directly on the screen).
3. Wipe the EDGE in a gentle motion to remove any dirt, dust, or finger marks.
4. Use a dry cloth to wipe any excess moisture.
5. Turn EDGE back on.

Other Tips:

- Please do not wipe the EDGE screen with wipes or other cleaners. Excessive moisture can damage the screen to the EDGE and make it unusable or unable to be repaired through warranty.
- Consider acquiring hard-tip stylus pens for the polling place. You would be able to wipe these pens down with alcohol wipes or solution. These are widely available on Amazon and other online sources.
- Have hand sanitizer throughout the polling place.
